

Indonesia Disaster Appeal Update

Just after our Disaster Aid Response Team volunteers left Palu (Indonesia), the Anak Krakatua volcano erupted setting off a tsunami that caused devastation to the coastal communities in Java and Sumatra in the Sunda Strait area.



Initial accounts put the number of deaths at over 400, with more than 1,400 injured. Since then these numbers have increased. Hundreds of thousands of people are now in need of water and shelter.

Will you please help us to help others?

- £250 will help purchase home repair kits.
- £50 will help supply a tarpaulin for home repair and/or a temporary shelter.
